


Quincy Bullen

Shaina Sammone






Kobena Aguaa-Harrison
























The Peaceful Home for Children, Kianyaga, Kenya

Responding to the need for a non-institutional, safe and nurturing environment for orphans, The Peaceful Home for Children was built. This private facility is run as a family unit by director Joe Njogo, along with his wife Agnes, the manager and matron in charge. They've been looking after orphans for more than 20 years, treating them with love and dedication, raising each as their own.

This includes an education. Schooling, up to grade eight, is free in Kenya, but a child cannot attend without a uniform, crushing the opportunity for many. Each child in our home will be given a uniform, and can then take their rightful place in the classroom.

But continuing beyond grade school can be a struggle. All students must write a high school entrance exam – and the staterun education system doesn't adequately prepare them. So our goal is now to send our children to private school, at a cost of \$1,100 USD per student per year, to give them a proper foundation.

And that's not the only hurdle. High school tuition is \$2,500 USD per year — a cost that is prohibitive to most.

In 2014, we started an education fund to ensure our children are able to keep learning. Attending high school will solidify their future, but we must raise \$225,000 to ensure all their education needs are met.

Indeed, with your generous donation, The Peaceful Home for Children will continue to provide a loving atmosphere for orphaned children, feeding their body and nourishing their minds.

As our children grow and become contributing citizens, it is our prayer they will spread the love and support the next generation.
