April 8, 2020

Trust you are all well and keeping safe in Canada. We are all safe here!

We have very restricted movements and cannot access certain areas. Nairobi is now cut off from the rest of the country completely. The sudden notice to cut off Nairobi has caught many of us off guard and separated families & work schedules as many people live in the outskirts of Nairobi and work in Nairobi.

Coronavirus has so far infected 172 people in Kenya, and the government has asked everybody to work from home. They have also introduced a dusk-to-dawn curfew from 7pm to 5am to minimize the spread at night, especially among young people who love going out.

Right now, travel has been discouraged, and we have barred any visits to the Peaceful Children's Home. This includes staff, who are unable to go in and out. Fortunately, Agnes has made arrangements with two employees to remain in the orphanage full time, making it safer for everybody.

We have water for washing hands, as well as sanitizer, and over the last two days have been stocking up in case of a lockdown - which is expected any time.

Agnes is also now permanently home with the kids, as any outside movement is discouraged. She is asking the children to help with chores as much as possible, giving them more shared responsibility, and keeping them busy.

Right now, like everyone else, people are afraid, as nobody knows what is coming next. Agnes is doing her best to keep everybody occupied and hopeful.

Thank you for sending funds to help us to prepare for any eventuality. We believe that within the next couple of days, we will be well stocked, as we have already ordered most of the essentials.

We will take some pictures of the kids doing their daily activities at the home, and send them to you. Thank you again for your kindness and support.
